The Country's Top Spots to Get Your Fall Leaf-Peeping On—In Style

South Carolina: Chimney Rock in Greenville

Watch the final scenes of *Last of the Mohicans*, and you'll get a good sense of what [Chimney Rock State Park](#) looks like. Set just outside of Greenville, South Carolina, the park was donated by the Morse family in 2007 and is one of the state's most iconic parks. In autumn, its color palette is dramatic—the hills and valleys are quilted in gold and green. Hike the Great Woodland Adventure Trail to the Four Seasons Trail, which climbs more than 400 feet up the Hickory Nut Gorge to Exclamation Point, the highest point in the Park at 2,480 feet. Along with the outcropping from which the park takes its name (a 315-foot-tall rock), don't miss hiking Hickory Nut Falls trail to the 404-foot-tall falls, one of the highest in the East. Plan more than a day to take it all in; stay at [Hotel Domestique](#), a short drive to the trail heads, and with a fantastic breakfast spread and a rustic Italian vibe.
