## Daufuskie Island, South Carolina

Ready to get away from it all? Like really get away from it all? This 1,100-acre island is only accessible via ferry from Hilton Head, South Carolina or water taxi—there isn't even a bridge. That also means you can leave your car on the mainland; visitors to the island tool around on electric golf carts. The island is home to an undeveloped nature conservancy oasis where you can spot loggerhead turtles, deer, storks, egrets, and whales. [Daufuskie Island Trail Rides](#) offers horseback rides on the beach and tours of the island's historic sites, including the First African Baptist School.
