



## GREENVILLE'S MAIN STREET

Small-town charm meets big-city style

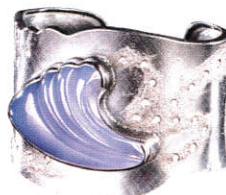

**A DARLING AMONG URBANISTS**, Greenville's Main Street has earned praise from *Travel + Leisure* and *Forbes* for resurrecting the South Carolina city's downtown. Here, plaid-clad hipsters and bike-riding families move seamlessly between restored restaurants, mixed-use hotels, and the Falls Park waterfront, where a sleek, suspended walkway, the Liberty Bridge, spans the Reedy waterfalls. Main Street's wide sidewalks are lined with modern sculptures and inspirational quotes ("Never cut what you can untie," advises one such passage). On weekends, a free trolley ferries visitors nearly two miles from end to end. Stay in the center of it all at the welcoming Courtyard Marriott, and time your visit to coincide with Artisphere (May 9–11), one of the country's top art festivals, complete with a street market and gallery shows.



### DARK CORNER DISTILLERY

Open two years, Dark Corner's moonshine has won more awards than any other corn whiskey in the world. Tour the distillery and, for \$3, sample its hand-mashed corn whiskeys, gins, and absinthes. [darkcornerdistillery.com](http://darkcornerdistillery.com)



### LYNN STRONG FINE ART JEWELRY

### MARY PRAYTOR GALLERY

A pioneer of Greenville's art scene, Praytor opened this Main Street institution in 1989. Peruse her collection of contemporary and folk art, mostly by regional artists with ties to the city. ### NOSE DIVE

This new gastropub offers an ever-changing menu of imaginatively topped burgers and whimsical cocktails like the

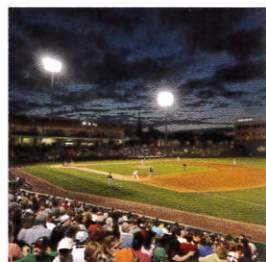


### POSTCARD FROM PARIS
