### Black Sheep & Prodigal Sons Mammoth Razor

Shaving with a flat-edge razor is mostly a thing of the past, relegated to old-school barbershops and specialty boutiques for men who still understand the value of a clean, close shave. But Derrick Cruz, designer of Black Sheep & Prodigal Sons, has gotten downright prehistoric with it. The Mammoth Straight Razor's sheath is made from 10,000-year-old woolly mammoth ivory, while the steel blade is salvaged and restored from a vintage razor. Cruz sources the Alaskan mammoth ivory from a certified dealer—there's a job you didn't know about. The razor also comes with a hidden Stanhope lens on the sheath. The lenses were employed in the 19th century for smuggling documents during wartime and can be customized with your personal image or message. The sheath can also be hand engraved. With this singular piece of history, getting your whiskers off will never get dull. —PR
